<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All entries must be delivered to the Eversley Centre, Low Street, Sherburn in Elmet LS25 6BA on <b>Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August between 14.00 and 19.00</b> Late entries will not be accepted.</li> <li>Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by a completed entry form and payment of the correct fee. The entry fee is £1 per item. You will be issued with a receipt which you should bring when you collect your entries.</li> </ol>
Judging and presentation
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Entries will be judged on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> August. All entrants are invited to attend the prize presentation which will take place on <b>Friday 24<sup>th</sup> August at 19:00</b> in the Eversley Centre.</li> <li>The competition will be judged by an independent judge appointed by the organisers of the event.
