<b>Conditions of entry for handicraft competitions</b>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All competition entries must have been produced or created by the person submitting the entry and must have been completed in the previous 12 months.</li> <li>2. Previous entries in the Sherburn Craft and Food Festival competitions are not allowed.</li> <li>3. No item can be entered into more than one category and must fit the general description for that category.</li> <li>4. Participants are allowed to enter a maximum of three items in each category.</li> <li>5. Entrants are recommended to arrange their own insurance cover for their entries. The Sherburn Craft and Food Festival and the Eversley Centre will not be financially liable for the loss or damage to any item however caused.</li> </ol>
<b>Submission</b>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6. All entries must be delivered to the Eversley Centre, Low Street, Sherburn in Elmet LS25 6BA on <b>Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August between 14.00 and 19.00</b> Late entries will not be accepted.</li> <li>7. Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by a completed entry form and payment of the correct fee. The entry fee is £2 per item. You will be issued with a receipt which you should bring when you collect your entries.</li> <li>8. Sherburn Craft and Food Festival will charge 10% commission on any items sold during the festival.</li> </ol>
<b>Judging and presentation</b>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>9. Entries will be judged on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> August. All entrants are invited to attend the prize presentation which will take place on <b>Friday 24<sup>th</sup> August at 19.00</b> in the Eversley Centre.</li> <li>10. The competition will be judged by an independent judge appointed by the organisers of the event. The judge's decisions will be final</li> </ol>

Viewing hours are 10.00-17.00 Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> and 10.00-14.00 Monday 27<sup>th</sup> August.</li> <li>13. Those wishing to view must be in possession of a current Sherburn Craft and Food Festival entry wrist band</li> </ol>

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>14. All entries MUST be collected between <b>14.00 and 18.00 on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> August</b> from the Eversley Centre.</li> <li>15. Any items not collected during that time may be disposed of at the organiser's discretion. No compensation will be paid.</li> <li>16. Please show your receipt to one of the event stewards to verify that you are the owner</li> <li>17. Please note that you will not be able to park outside the Eversley Centre at this time as this area is the designated parking area for Blue Badge permit holders only.</li> </ol>
