

Conditions of entry for photography competition

General
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entry to the competition is restricted to residents living within a ten mile radius of Sherburn in Elmet. • Competition images must have been taken after 01/01/2018 by the person submitting the entry, and must not have been submitted previously to the Sherburn craft and food festival. • Participants may submit up to two photographs in each of the classes (subject to age restriction. Prints can be up to a maximum size of A4 (297mm x 210mm). Prints may be mounted on card. • Entrants are recommended to arrange their own insurance cover for their entries. The Sherburn Festival and the Eversley Centre will not be financially liable for the loss or damage to any item however caused.
Submission
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All entries must be delivered to the Eversley Centre, Low Street, Sherburn in Elmet LS25 6BA on Thursday 22nd August between 17.00 and 20.00 Late entries will not be accepted. • Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by the payment of the appropriate fees. The submission fee is £2 per item • The image title and class entered must be clearly displayed on the reverse of the photograph. • Each entry must bear a label on the reverse that includes the entrant's name, contact details, (email or telephone) and a price if the item is for sale. There is a 10% commission to be paid on sales.
Judging and presentation
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entries will be judged on Friday 23th August. All entrants are invited to attend the prize presentation which will take place on Friday 23th August at 19:30 in the Eversley Centre. • The number of prizes awarded will be dependent upon the number of entries for each category. ie 7 or more entries will attract 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. 4 -6 entries will attract 1st and 2nd place. 1 -3 entries will attract 1st place only. • The competition will be judged by an independent judge appointed by the event organisers. The judge's decisions will be final

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All entries to the competition must be available for public viewing at the Eversley Centre during the festival • Viewing hours are 10.00-17.00 Saturday 24th and Sunday 25th and 10.00-15.00 Monday 26th August.
Collection
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All entries MUST be collected between 15.00 and 17.00 on Monday 26th August from the Eversley Centre. • Any items not collected during that time may be disposed of at the organiser's discretion. No compensation will be paid. • Please note that you will not be able to park outside the Eversley Centre at this time as this area is the designated parking area for Blue Badge permit holders only.
